

AFC Doctoral Tutorial

29 May 2024

The AFC Doctoral Tutorial is designed to help doctoral students progress in their research through workshops organised during the day preceding the congress.

As in previous years, participants will be asked to present and discuss their research work in front of a panel of professors. Professors chosen for their expertise in the field will provide a critical evaluation.

Those wishing to participate in this day are invited to submit their application with the following three documents:

- the completed information sheet;
- a one-page mini-CV;
- the state of progress of the thesis.

Concerning the state of progress of the research (monographic thesis or by articles), a Word document of 10 pages maximum is expected, starting with a summary of 150 words maximum and detailing the problematic of the research, theoretical framework(s) and method used, and the results to date and eventual difficulties encountered or anticipated, and the references. The format should be as follows: double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font, and A4 size page. For further instructions, you may refer to those in [Comptabilité Contrôle Audit \(CCA\)/Accounting Auditing Control \(AAC\)](#) available on the AFC website.

In principle, the document should help you to show how your thesis proposal addresses some of the key questions asked of any research work: How novel is my proposal? What are its expected contributions? Are the objectives of my research logical and coherent? Is my research likely to produce new concepts and data or confirm existing hypotheses? Is the research method appropriate, adequate and feasible for the desired and/or conducted research? What are the expected results? These questions are not exhaustive and should be adapted to your PhD year.

The first page of this document should include the information sheet which can be downloaded from the AFC website and the second page should include the mini-CV.

Decisions will be notified to you by 15 March 2024. The deadline for registration for PhD students is 15 April 2024 and for non-communicating participants 15 May 2024. The registration gives access to all the events of the congress (parallel sessions, inaugural conference, symposia, WG meetings... and the gala!).
